1. Overview

The table below outlines the activities scheduled from November 11 to 19, 2026. Events organized as part of the 20th Francophonie Summit, as well as those taking place alongside the Summit, will be held primarily in Phnom Penh from November 14 to 17.

Additional activities are also offered in Vietnam, both before the Summit (SIAL Vietnam) and after the Summit (Trade Mission to Vietnam).

2. Overview of the main activities

► SIAL Vietnam (11–14 November 2026)

SIAL Vietnam is an international trade show dedicated to the agri-food sector, bringing together producers, processors, distributors, importers, and food industry solution providers. It offers businesses an opportunity to discover trends in the Vietnamese market, expand their professional network, and explore business opportunities across Southeast Asia.

- Explore export opportunities and strategic partnerships.

► Francophonie Village (14–16 November 2026)

The Francophonie Village will take place in Phnom Penh from November 14 to 16, 2026. Program details will be announced at a later date.

► Rencontre des entrepreneurs francophones (REF) (14–15 November 2026)

The REF (*Francophone Entrepreneurs Meeting*) is organized by the Alliance des Patronats Francophones (APF) in collaboration with the Cambodia Chamber of Commerce (CCC). It brings together entrepreneurs, business organizations, and economic decision-makers from across the Francophone world to foster business exchanges and international partnerships. The program includes B2B meetings, conferences, roundtable discussions, and a gala luncheon. Participation is free of charge for international delegations.

Benefits for participating companies:

- Expand their Francophone business network.
- Participate in targeted B2B meetings.
- Connect with economic decision-makers from numerous countries.

► 20th Francophonie Summit (15–16 November 2026)

The 20th Francophonie Summit will take place in Phnom Penh on November 15 and 16, 2026. Program details will be announced at a later date.

► **FrancoTech (15–16 November 2026)**

FrancoTech is the flagship economic and technology event held alongside the Francophonie Summit. It will bring together governments, businesses, investors, educational institutions, and innovation stakeholders through an Innovation Village, exhibition, roundtable discussions, B2B meetings, investment sessions, and an innovation competition. The detailed program is currently being finalized.

Benefits for participating companies:

- Connect with potential partners and investors.
- Develop business opportunities across the Francophone world and the ASEAN region.

► **France–Cambodia Business Forum (16–17 November 2026)**

Organized by the France Cambodia Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCIFC), with the support of the Ministry of Commerce of Cambodia, the Forum aims to strengthen economic ties between France and Cambodia. The program includes panel discussions, sector-specific workshops, B2B and B2G meetings, and networking opportunities. Key sectors include infrastructure, agri-food, healthcare, energy, construction, logistics, tourism, water, and the environment.

Benefits for participating companies:

- Gain a better understanding of the Cambodian market.
- Connect with government representatives and local businesses.
- Develop commercial partnerships.

► **Trade Mission to Vietnam (17–19 November 2026)**

Organized by the France Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry (CCIFV), this trade mission is offered following the Francophonie Week in Cambodia to provide participating companies with an opportunity to deepen their understanding of the Vietnamese market. The program includes market briefings, institutional meetings, company visits, networking activities, and a tour of an industrial park. The participation fee is €450 (excluding VAT) per participant, excluding airfare and accommodation.

Benefits for participating companies:

- Assess the potential of the Vietnamese market.
- Meet institutional and commercial partners.
- Gain insight into the local industrial ecosystem and supply chains.
